

As early as the Talmudic era, the Sages knew the Messiah should have come already, they cried all the predestined dates for the redemption have passed and the matter now depends only on repentance and good deeds" Sanhedrin 97B.

The Talmud also states the temples destruction of 70AD was indeed predicted by Daniel 9:24-27. God spent a thousand years promising Abraham and David the Messiah would descend from them. When He allowed all the genealogies to be destroyed in the second temple it was obvious, the Messiah should have come. For we read in the Talmud "and the Sanhedrin wept, Oy vo voy l'anu" "Woe to us, for the temple has been destroyed and the Messiah has not come Jesus was the only person who claimed to be the Messiah before the destruction of the second Temple and who could actually, in his time, prove Davidic decent. So it stands to reason on the testimony of the Prophet Daniel and the whole Tenach, that if Jesus is not the Messiah there will be no Messiah.

## The Facts are:

- ✧ Messiah would come 483 years after the decree to rebuild Jerusalem. The only decree that fits the context of the prophecy is that of Artaxerxes to Nehemiah in 444 BCE (Nehemiah 2:1-8)
- ✧ Messiah would be legally executed
- ✧ Messiahs death would result in the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple
- ✧ Messiahs birth and death, therefore, must both have happened prior to 70CE



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
